

Offer Major Claim Support to Your Team

A low-cost employee benefit most small employers can't otherwise offer.

What it is

A \$250 one-time setup fee, then \$50 per year for each enrolled employee (3-employee minimum) — bringing real, ongoing help with medical bills, insurance denials and charity-care paperwork within reach of a local employer with a handful of staff.

Why it matters

- An employee working through an unresolved medical bill or insurance denial is dealing with a real, time-consuming problem during working hours, whether or not it shows up on a timesheet.
- It's a concrete, practical benefit aimed at one of the more disruptive things an employee's household can face — at a price point most employee-benefit categories cannot match.
- A locally-run, 501(c)(3) nonprofit benefit signals that an employer is willing to help with something real, not just offer another unused perk.

What your team gets, per enrolled employee

- An onboarding handout and an annual orientation webinar
- Ongoing navigation help with medical bills, insurance denials and charity-care paperwork
- Access to MBHA's 15-guide Healthcare Quick Guides library
- A dedicated employer admin contact — billing and enrollment only, never personal health details
- The Monthly Wellness Program, at no added cost

The cost

\$250 one-time setup, then \$50/year per enrolled employee — 3-employee minimum. Because headcount varies, this isn't a self-serve checkout: a short form collects your estimated employee count and MBHA follows up to confirm enrollment and send an invoice sized to your business.
